- Manage aftercare services for clients discharged from hospital settings
- Follow up on missed or canceled appointments when clinically necessary
- Respond appropriately to emergency situations
- Meet assigned quarterly productivity expectations

- Maintain timely, accurate, and concise clinical documentation (completed within one working day)
- Adhere to all agency policies, procedures, and Medicaid/DMH requirements
